Colombia is the only country in the continental Americas that does not grant automatic birthright citizenship. To obtain Colombian citizenship at birth, a person must have at least one parent who is a citizen or legal resident of Colombia.

Colombia is a social state under the rule of law, organized in the form of a unitary republic, decentralized, with autonomy of its territorial units, democratic, participatory, and pluralistic, based on the respect of human dignity, the work and solidarity of the individuals who belong to it, and the prevalence of the general interest.

Colombia's Constitution of 1991 with Amendments through 2005

Article 4. The Constitution is the supreme law. In all cases of incompatibility between the Constitution and the law or any other legislation or regulation, the constitutional provisions will apply. It is the duty of citizens and of aliens in Colombia to abide by the Constitution and the laws, and to respect and obey the authorities. Article 5.

Text of the Constitution of Colombia (1991)

The Colombian State may recognize the jurisdiction of the International Criminal Court in terms of the Rome Statute adopted on July 17, 1998 by the United Nations Plenipotentiary's Conference and, consequently, ratify said treaty in accordance with the procedure established by this Constitution.

The Constitution provides the norm of regulations. In all cases of incompatibility between the Constitution and the statute or other legal regulations, the constitutional provisions shall apply. It is the duty of citizens and of aliens in Colombia to obey the Constitution and the laws, and to respect and obey the authorities.

Colombian citizenship, governed by the Constitution of Colombia and the 1st Act of 2002, is primarily based on the principles of jus soli (right of the soil) and jus sanguinis (right of blood). Colombia permits dual citizenship. The Constitution provides that Colombian nationality is not lost when a citizen acquires another nationality.

Colombian citizens by naturalization and aliens domiciled in Colombia cannot be obligated to take up arms against their country of origin; neither may Colombians who have acquired citizenship abroad against the country of their new citizenship.
