The assessments in the test attempt to gauge areas of language, visuospatial abilities, memory and recall and abstract thinking, to give a representation of a person's current cognitive ability.

### MOCA-Montreal Cognitive Assessment Test Form

The Montreal Cognitive Assessment (MoCA) is a one page, 30 point test that takes about 10 minutes and doesn't require the doctor to have any special training. The MoCA usually tests these cognitive areas: Ability to process and understand visual information about where objects are.

This was a validation study of the Mini-Mental State Exam (MMSE) and the Montreal Cognitive Assessment (MoCA), using the Cognistat, as the criterion or 'gold standard'.
